Item 5. Other Events

On November 3, 1998, California voters defeated the Voter Initiative (also known as Proposition 9) that would have amended state law related to AB 1890 so as to, among other things, prohibit recovery by the state's investor-owned electric utilities of their investments in nuclear generating plants. The vote was approximately 27% in favor of the Initiative and 73% opposed.
